The definitions applicable to the ISPO Control Manual:

- <u>Administrator</u> is designated by the Board on the responsibility of the Chairman for the administration of the IUG activities; the Administrator represents the IUG and is an advisor to all Associates.

- International Users Group of ISPO-certified Organizations (IUG) is the body which is responsible for the ISPO on behalf of the ISPO-certified pilot organizations.

- IUG Chairman is appointed by means of a binding proposal by the Meeting of Associates.

Definitions

The definitions applicable to the ISPO Control Manual:

- <u>Administrator</u> is designated by the Board on the responsibility of the Chairman for the administration of the IUG activities; the Administrator represents the IUG and is an advisor to all Associates.
- Associate is a member of the IUG.
- International Users Group of ISPO-certified Organizations (IUG) is the body which is responsible for the ISPO on behalf of the ISPO-certified pilot organizations.
- <u>Head office</u> is the site that is responsible for and centrally controls the single management system.
- <u>IUG Board</u> is a group of elected members responsible for management and conduct of the IUG.
- <u>IUG Chairman</u> is appointed by means of a binding proposal by the Meeting of Associates.
- Multi-site certification is a certification of an organization with multiple sites-under one certificate.
- <u>Multi-site Pilot Organization</u> is an organization of at least two sites covered by a single management system comprising an identified head office.

• <u>Site</u> is where a pilot organization performs work or from which a service is provided on a continuing basis.
